It was Christmas, but it didn't feel like Christmas. Kim and I were on a team of five young people who had recently arrived in what was then called Zaire to share music, drama, and puppets (yes, Sigmund was with us) with our African brothers and sisters. We were living in a simple mission compound with a large group of African Christians. There was no snow or anything we recognized as Christmas decorations. My family was somewhere on the other side of the world

celebrating with all the trimmings and family warmth that I remembered from my childhood. I had tried to go to the market to buy my young wife a Christmas present, but I didn't think she would appreciate roasted termites or corn and there wasn't much else to choose from. The church had a 7-hour Christmas service, but we couldn't understand a word. We gave up after a couple of hours. It was the least Christmassy Christmas I had ever experienced.
