

Through the One Parish One Prisoner program (<u>One Parish One Prisoner — Underground Ministries</u>), our congregation is partnering with Jonathan. Jonathan committed a crime as a teenager for which he has spent the last 14 years in prison. He has worked hard to change his life. Our congregation has formed a relationship with Jonathan and his wife, Angelie. We love them and want to see them thrive as Jonathan leaves prison.

In October 2021, we will be raising money to support Jonathan and Angelie as Jonathan gets out of prison and is deported to Mexico. Jonathan has done amazing work to try to get his life together and he wants to be a productive member of society. However, he will be moving to Mexico. Jonathan left Mexico as a young child. Angelie has never lived there. They have some family there but will have nothing to start their new life. Jonathan owes almost \$7,000 in fines from the State. He will need about \$3500 to get started. That will include money to get home from where he is dropped off in Tijuana, clothes, shoes, a haircut, first month's rent (\$350), Mexican ID, a phone, transportation, etc. God has put us in a position to help Jonathan. He has a lot of hurdles to make a life in a country in which he will be a stranger. Let's join together to see how we can help him start a new life.
